Arts Commission of Danville/Boyle County	Expanded Youth and Community Arts Program	Our project will provide arts activities and services to the youth of Boyle County through the Youth Arts Fair, programs for special needs young adults, special exhibits for youth at local businesses and venues, and a youth arts camp.
Assisting Deaf Adults to Participate Totally (KyADAPT)	KyADAPT Safe and Healthy Living Project	The KyADAPT Safe and Healthy Living project will teach our 20 clients to achieve and maintain significantly safer, healthier lifestyles. It will feature group independent living skills classes, in-home follow up, and participation in community programs which promote physical and mental health.
Boyle County Education Foundation, Inc.	Boyle County Preschool Grant	Scholarships that would provide preschool opportunities to students who do not qualify through income or disability, but do not have the finances to pay out of pocket costs to attend.
Camp Horsin' Around	2019 Archery Deck	We seek matching funding for an archery deck for campers to shoot targets, shelter from the sun, and observe others in the archery area. The archery activity is currently unshaded, and access is difficult for health compromised campers who cannot endure extreme heat or direct sunlight.
Community Arts Center, Inc.	ASL Interpretation for Arts Programs	The Community Arts Center seeks funding to make our educational programming more accessible to members of our community who are deaf or hard-of-hearing. This grant will underwrite the cost of facilitating programs and events during which sign language interpretation is available.
Danville Schools Education Foundation Inc.	Parents as Teachers/Cradle School	Empower parents to take a lead role in early childhood education with peer mentoring, home visits with educational professionals, and interaction with others involved in early childhood development.
Danville/Boyle County Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet	Shoes/socks for public school students in need	Happy Feet provides economically disadvantaged students in public schools in Boyle County with quality shoes and socks so they are better prepared to engage in learning at school.
Danville-Boyle County Senior Citizens Inc.	Activities of Daily Living Transportation Grant	Our Transportation Assistance Service provides free transportation for Senior Citizens to and from our Center, physician appointments, pharmacies, grocery stores, etc. to allow Seniors in Boyle County to remain independent and in their own homes as long as possible
Family Services Association of Boyle County	Emergency Financial Assistance	FSA will use the requested funds to assist with providing safe housing, for a period of no less than 30 days, for economically disadvantaged families with children. This may include paying a portion of the family's rent, or preventing disconnection of an essential utility.
