

2021 Hudson-Ellis Discretionary Grant Recipients

- **Art Center of the Bluegrass - \$3,575** - to support free family arts programming
- **Arts Commission of Danville-Boyle County - \$3,040** - to support the Youth Art Fair and arts programming for participants with special needs
- **Bluegrass Community & Technical College Foundation - \$10,000** - to support the “Degree Before Diploma” Scholarship fund that will aid high school juniors and seniors in Boyle County with the cost of taking dual credit classes.
- **Bluegrass Council of the Blind - \$2,000** – to support an Orientation and Mobility Clinic for Boyle County residents ages 13 through adult
- **Boyle County Schools - \$10,000** - to provide scholarships for pre-School students
- **CASA of the Bluegrass - \$2,500** - to support child victim advocacy volunteer training
- **Centro Latino de Danville, KY - \$10,000** – to support English classes, tutoring for K-12 students, as well as health services and health education for disadvantaged Boyle County students and families whose primary language is not English
