

2023 Grant Recipients

- **Allegro Dance Project - \$1,500** to support a free Inclusive Dance Outreach Program in Boyle County that benefits students with Down Syndrome, autism spectrum disorder, and other specific needs.
- **Art Center of the Bluegrass - \$2,500** to support Art and Wellness program, including art therapy and an open studio for disabled adults.
- **Boyle County Performing Arts Center - \$1,000** for the purchase of books to students attending The Very Hungry Caterpillar Show.
- **Camp Horsin' Around - \$2,500** for General Operating Support.
- **Centro Latino of Danville/Boyle Count - \$10,000** for General Operating Support
- **Danville High School - \$10,000** to support the cost of dual enrollment classes for juniors and seniors.
- **Danville/Boyle County Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet - \$10,000** to support program that provides shoes and socks to students in need in Boyle County.
- **Family Services Association of Boyle County - \$10,000** to support Emergency Housing Assistance program that helps prevent homelessness.
- **The Gladys Project - \$3,927** to Ready Set Go Preschool, a kindergarten readiness program that supports preschool age children living in and round low-income housing in Boyle County.
